A games and football pitch for children in Orlat

Children's Home in Orlat / Romania

In the state children's home of Orlat, the largest of its kind in Sibiu County, 100 children - between two and seventeen years of age - currently have their home. All children come from socially difficult backgrounds: are orphans or have parents who cannot take care of them. More than half of them belong to the Roma minority.

Although the basic needs of everyday life such as shelter, hot meals and water, heating and basic medical care are covered, educational opportunities for follow-up and sporting activities are lacking due to difficult economic conditions. Currently only 19 professional educators look after the children and young people who attend the kindergarten or the school together with local children.

Many of the children are, due to their mental state, seen as „hyperactive“, have an exaggerated urge to move around or show grave learning disabilities. They need a lot of attention and support - for example, in just doing the daily homework. Also sporting activities and challenges during play can help to counteract the inner restlessness of these children and adolescents. The following aims apply: to inspire and promote all children through games, sports and other recreational activities. The children's home Orlat has neither a games nor a football pitch.

That should change as soon as possible: Bosch Rexroth Romania and Primavera are planning and organising the construction of a games and sports facility. Building

permits are applied for and construction is to begin in September 2013. We will inform you about the progress of this aid project.
